Community Garden Overview

The community garden consists of individual plots or beds of various sizes. Currently there are some at 2x4, 4x6, 6x8 and 6x9. Depending on the level of interest for 2021, the group will potentially restructure the garden in the spring to better match the needs of the 2021 group.

Garden plots/beds are assigned for the season and are the responsibility of that season's owner.

All soil amendments, vegetable and flower plants, supplies, etc. are the responsibility of the season's owner.

Watering and weeding of a plot is the responsibility of the season's owner.

There are currently no garden membership dues.

In 2020, many common needs (landscaping fabric & pegs, wood chips, hoses and spray nozzles) were donated by our developers or garden members. The seven member households each paid \$13.99 to cover the cost of the edging for the pathway leading from the clubhouse to the garden.
